Exploring Windows 98



The Welcome Screen

- When a computer is started for the first time.
- There are four options on the welcome screen.
- **Connect to the Internet**
 - Launches the internet wizard. Lets you get on the www quickly
- **Discover Windows 98**
 - Launches an online tutorial
- **Maintain Your Computer**
 - Launches the maintenance wizard
 - Allows you to set times for running scandisk, defrag, and cleanup.
- **Register Now**
 - Used to register a new O.S.



Customizing Your Desktop

- **Web Style**

- Allows you to see everything as a web page
- Programs open in a single window, versus separate windows.

- **Classic Style**

- Reverts back to the win95 windows default style

- **Custom Style**

- This allows you to pick and choose the options you want.



The New Internet Explorer Interface

- If you have chosen web style, all folders will have some generic buttons at the top of the screen.
- **Standard Buttons**
 - Common commands, like cut, copy, paste, save, etc...
- **Address Bar**
 - This will show the path to where you are at.
- **Links**
 - Take you directly to featured pages, or you can create your own.



The New Internet Explorer Interface

- **Radio**

- This allows you to listen to radio stations over the internet.

- **Desktop**

- This option is only available on the taskbar. Allows you to access My Computer while keeping other windows available.

- **Quick Launch**

- On the Task bar. Allows you to quickly open select folders.
